- ↳ Batteries - Industrial Stationary and Non-Lead Acid Motive²
- ↳ Corrosives (includes irritants)
- ↳ Fertilizers¹
- ↳ Fire Extinguishers (portable)
- ↳ Flammables¹ (includes solvents)
- ↳ Fluorescents (user removed)
- ↳ Oil Containers
- ↳ Oil Filters
- ↳ Paint and Coatings¹

Available in denominations of

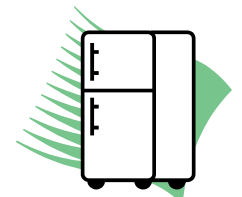
\$50, \$100 and \$200

Refrigeration tags must be purchased by anyone disposing of an old refrigerator or freezer.

Appliances must be dropped off at the Waste Transfer Station on Saturdays.

Where do I place my recycling?

CURBSIDE RECYCLING every second week

Place recyclables in blue bags. If possible, place recyclables 1.5 meters (5 feet) away from your garbage cans at the curb.



What days and times do I recycle?

What about reusable items?

RE-USE / RECYCLE CENTRE

ONLY

What kinds of reusable items?

Acceptable Products:

↳ Bicycles



↳ Clean Wood (no nails and attached drywall, or other types of materials)

↳ Products in good working order that can be taken home without any rework (at the discretion of the reusable centre operator).

How do I sort it all out?

BLUE BAG #1 (Containers)

Plastics

- ↳ plastic containers
- ↳ throw lids away
- ↳ check your plastic for the sign



Food, beverage, metal & aluminum cans

- ↳ rinse metal cans and place loose in bag

Aluminum foil wrap & trays

- ↳ rinse, crumple foil, flatten trays, and place loose in bag

Milk cartons & juice boxes

- ↳ remove straws
- ↳ rinse and flatten
- ↳ place flattened cartons inside an open carton



What about paper and cardboard?

BLUE BAG #2 (Fibres)

- ↳ Newspapers, flyers, magazines, auto-trader, telephone books, game books, hardcover books (remove cover), egg cartons, cores from paper towel and toilet tissues rolls, cereal boxes (liner removed), office paper, envelopes, paperbacks, household and fine paper.

Cardboard boxes ("corrugated" waffle)

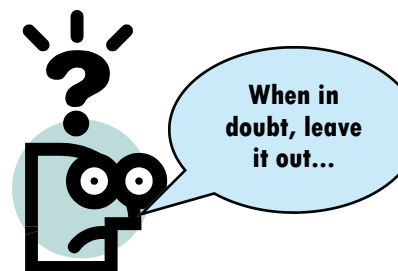
- ↳ flatten, bundle, tie with string
- ↳ place beside bags at the curb
- ↳ pizza boxes (clean)
- ↳ **maximum size (3'x 2'x 1')**



What can't I recycle?

We Just Can't Take It

- Styrofoam
- Hazardous waste
- Glass
- Dishes
- Container lids
- Plastic bags or film
- Gift wrap, i.e., Christmas wrapping paper
- Waxed cover boxes such as soap boxes



Can I recycle electronics?

Recycle your electronics

As of April 1, 2010, you can bring back even more of your unwanted electronics.

- Amplifiers
- Audio/video players
- Cameras
- Cell phones
- Computers
- Copiers
- Fax machines
- Monitors
