Being aware of the aforementioned, the municipality would like to notify the general public that with the "Penn Lake Park Revitalization and Enhancement Project", certain restrictions on snow vehicle use in the park are necessary. These prohibitions have been put in place to safeguard the health, safety and well-being of park users including snowmobilers; not to mention the prevention of damage to taxpayer property.

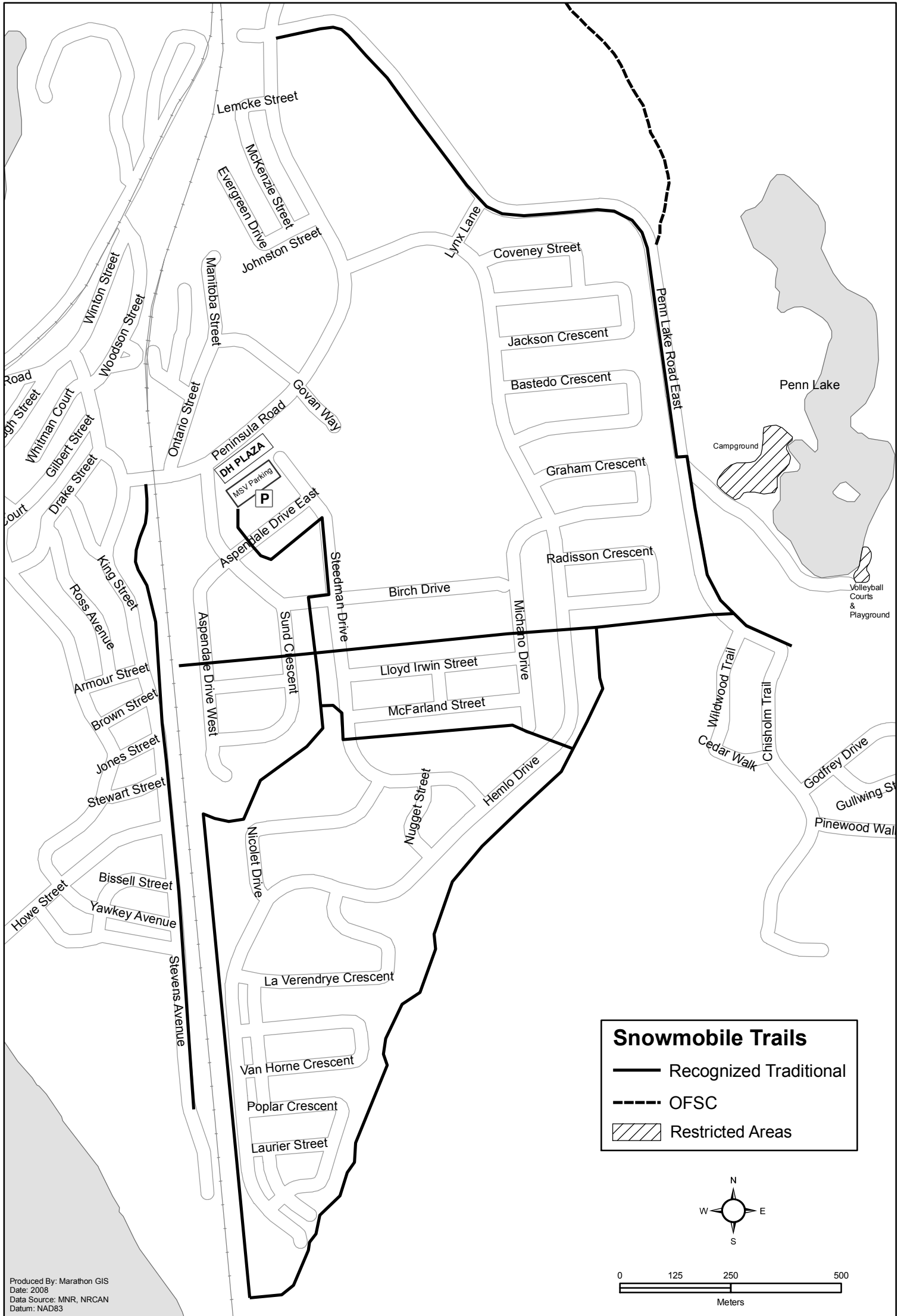
Effective immediately snow vehicles are prohibited from operating in the newly designed trailer/campground area and the playground and volleyball court areas. These sites now contain "under snow" hazards which, if hit could cause serious personal injury to riders and/or severe damage to property.

The municipality will always encourage responsible use of its resources throughout the four seasons; but as guardian of the facilities it must do everything in its power to keep them safe.

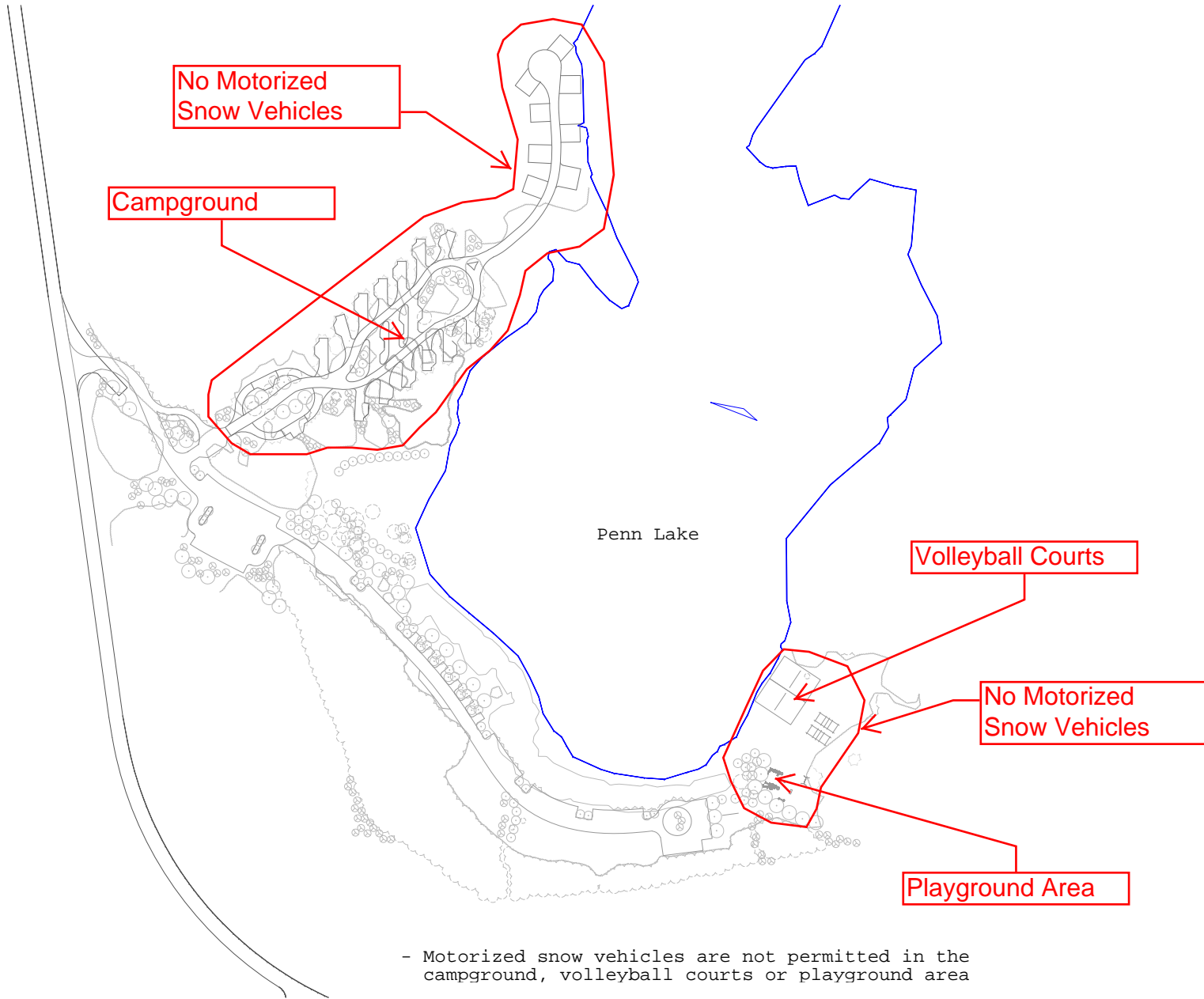
