

E-CHANNEL LEARNING HAS ARRIVED IN MARATHON!!!

The Marathon Area Action Centre (Centre), in partnership with the Schreiber/Terrace Bay Adult Learning Centre (ALC), is pleased to announce that we have a new e-Channel Learning computer lab!

A growing emphasis is being put on the use of e-Channel learning, an initiative funded by the Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities, which offers everything from basic training sessions in the use of e-Channel learning to advanced applications.

E-Channel learning is available through a project entitled *Good Learning Anywhere*. *Good Learning Anywhere* involves distance delivery programs administered through the Sioux Hudson Literacy Council, a non-profit, community-based, client-centered Literacy and Basic Skills Program. The mandate of the project is to offer a variety of literacy and numeracy programs to adult learners.
