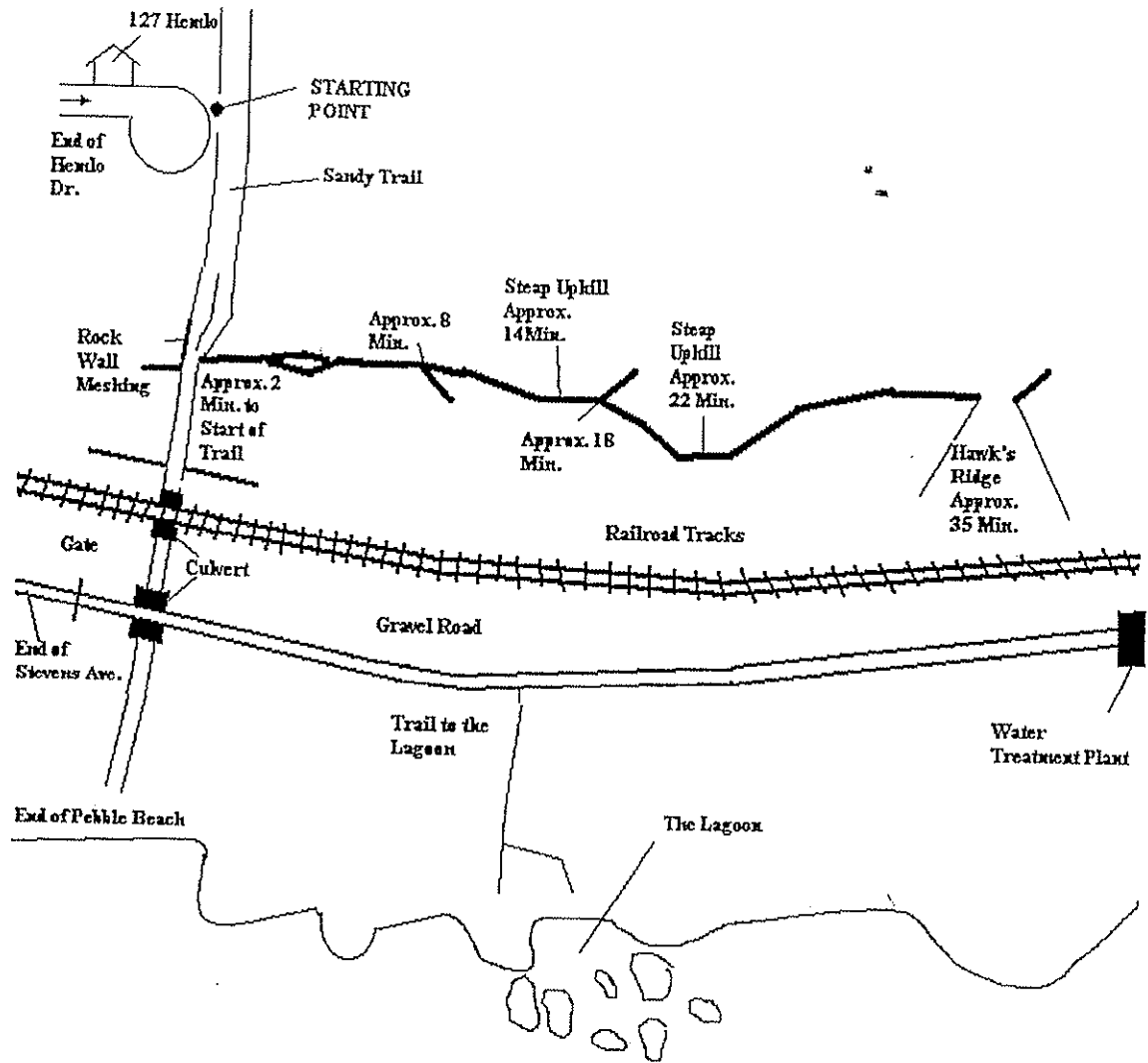


Hawk's Ridge and The Lagoon



Hawk's Ridge was formed over 10,000 years ago after the last glacier movement. It acquired its name from the occasional sighting of hawk's in the area. At a vertical height of 350 feet, hawk's ridge offers an immaculate view of Lake Superior and the area.

The Lagoon is a natural land formation on the shore of Lake Superior. Thousands of years of erosion has resulted in beautifully rounded rocks stretching into the lake. Many locals swim at the lagoon because it is protected from the larger waves coming off of the lake, due to the rocks in the area.
