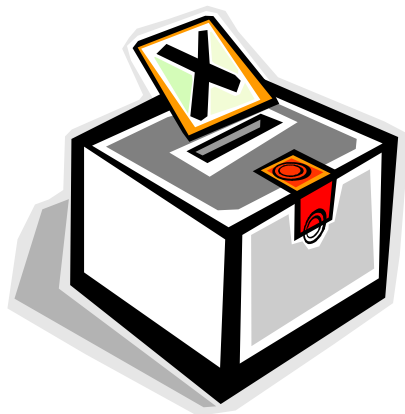


# ELECTIONS 2010

On October 25, 2010 municipal and school board elections will be held in our municipality.

## OFFICES TO BE ELECTED

In this election you will be electing the following representatives:

### **Municipal Council:**

One Mayor & 5 Councillors

### **English Public School Board:**

Two Trustees to be elected

### **English Separate School Board:**

One Trustee to be elected

### **French Public School Board:**

One Trustee to be elected

### **French Separate School Board:**

Two Trustees to be elected

## WHO MAY VOTE?

Any person who on Voting Day meets the following qualifications is eligible to vote:

1. Is a Canadian Citizen;
2. Is at least 18 years old on Voting Day;
3. Resides in the municipality or is the owner, tenant or spouse of the owner or tenant of land;
4. Is not prohibited, by law, from voting.

## THE FOLLOWING PEOPLE ARE NOT ENTITLED TO VOTE

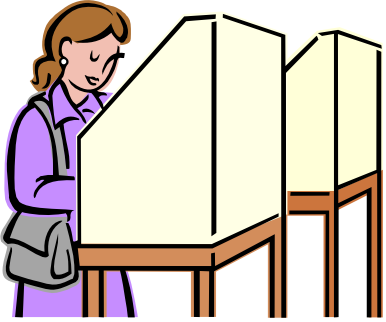
The *Municipal Elections Act*, 1996 prohibits the following individuals from voting:

1. Any person who is not a qualified voter;
2. A person who is serving a sentence of imprisonment in a penal or correctional institution;
3. A corporation;
4. A person acting as an executor or trustee;
5. A person who has been convicted of corrupt practices under the *Municipal Elections Act*, 1996 in the last four years;
6. Anyone who is prohibited, by law, from voting.

## WHERE DO I VOTE?

The Clerk will notify electors where they vote by placing an advertisement in the local newspaper.

## ADVANCE VOTING



In addition to the regular Voting Place, advance voting will once again take place in our municipality. Notice as to dates and locations will be provided by the Clerk in the fall.

### AM I ON THE VOTERS' LIST?

A list of all eligible voters will be available by September 10, 2010. You may call to inquire whether you are on the list by contacting the Office of the Clerk at (807) 229-1340, ext. 2223. This list is available for inspection during regular business hours (Monday to Friday from 10:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.) at the Office of the Clerk.

If you are not on the Voters' List or if the information about you is incorrect, you must go to the Office of the Clerk and fill out an application to be added to or to correct the List. All applications of revision must be in

the designated form, properly completed and signed by the applicant. Identification will be required. Please note that the Clerk may require proof of qualification as an elector. Please call the Office of the Clerk to determine what documentation you may need.

### WHAT SCHOOL BOARD DO I VOTE FOR?

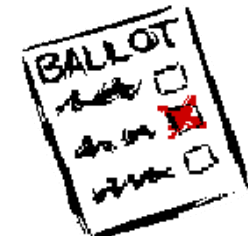
It is important you check your status on the Voters' List to determine whether you have been listed as an elector of the correct school board. If the listing is incorrect, you must attend at the Office of the Clerk to amend the list prior to attending the Voting Place.

You are only permitted to vote once for your School Board Trustee even if you own more than one property in more than one municipality that is contained within the jurisdiction of the School Board.

### HOW DO I APPOINT SOMEONE TO VOTE ON MY BEHALF?

If you are unable to attend at a Voting Place on any of the dates set for voting, you may appoint someone to act as your proxy. This allows you to appoint another eligible elector to attend at the Voting Place and vote on your behalf.

Please contact the Clerk's Office to obtain detailed information regarding the appointment of a proxy.
