### The Corporation of the Town of Marathon Pandemic Planning COVID-19 Update – Municipal Recreation Facility Re-openings

**MARATHON, ON; July 20, 2021** – The Town of Marathon remains diligent in monitoring the situation as it pertains to COVID-19. We continue to evaluate all Public Health Agency communications as well as communications from other Federal and Provincial Government Health Authorities. The health and well-being of our residents is of great importance.

With Ontario now in Step Three of the provincial re-opening plan as of July 16, the following municipal recreation facilities will be reopening with COVID-19 protocols in place:

- Lakeview Community Hall will re-open on July 21 for fitness classes and bookings;
- Peninsula Golf Course Clubhouse will be open for in-person dining starting July 21;
- Marathon Arena will open for the summer ice season on August 16 with the regular ice season to start September 7; and
- Port Hole Pool will open on September 7.

“The reopening of our recreation facilities will be a major boost for our residents. We have a very active community and quality recreation facilities, so to see them reopening is great for everyone’s well-being. But I continue to encourage our residents to get vaccinated if they have not yet done so.” states Mayor Rick Dumas.
