Minimum Tender Amount: \$8,030.20

According to the last returned assessment roll, the assessed value of the land is \$35,500

Tenders must be submitted in the prescribed form either typewritten or legibly handwritten in ink. Tenders must be accompanied by a deposit in the form of a money order or of a bank draft or cheque certified by a bank or trust corporation (credit unions are not eligible) payable to the municipality and representing at least 20 percent of the tender amount. Note that 20% must always be rounded off to the "HIGHER" cent (ie. for example, if you tender \$5,000.01 then 20% of \$5,000.01 is \$1,000.002 – therefore \$1000.00 would be less than 20% of the amount you tendered - \$1,000.01 would be the minimum deposit required). Tenders must be submitted in a **sealed** envelope addressed to the Treasurer with the words "Tax Sale – [6 Coveney](#)" written on the envelope.

Except as follows, the municipality makes no representation regarding the title to or any other matters relating to the land to be sold. Responsibility for ascertaining these matters rests with the potential purchaser.

This sale is governed by the Municipal Act, 2001, and the Municipal Tax Sales Rules made under that Act. The successful purchaser will be required to pay the amount tendered plus accumulated taxes and the relevant land transfer tax.

The municipality has no obligation to provide vacant possession to the successful purchaser.

Note: HST may be payable by successful purchaser.
