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BUILDING PERMITS



Did you know that the The OBC has increased the size of shed you can build without a permit to 15m² (160 ft²). The following requirements apply;

- Not more than 1 storey in height;
- Not attached to any building or structure;
- Only used for storage purposes ancillary to the principal building on the lot:
- Must not have plumbing;
- Must comply with all Zoning By-Law #1873 requirements.

BY-LAW 1905

The Municipal Law Enforcement department is currently conducting an inoperable vehicle blitz starting. Any residents with inoperable vehicles on their property that do not meet the by-law requirements will be provided notices and next steps to become compliant. In the event that property owners still do not comply further actions will be taken which could include the removal of the vehicle(s) at the owners expense and monetary fines.

To date 8 vehicles have been removed by the Municipality during this blitz.

REMINDER! OUTDOOR WATER-USE BYLAW IN EFFECT



Now that the nice weather is upon us we want to remind residents of the Watering Grass By-Law.

Watering restrictions are put in place through a Municipal By-Law to make sure residents water their lawns on appropriate days to lessen the impact on the local water supply during peak times.

What days can you water? Odd numbered addresses can water on odd calendar days; Even numbered addresses can water on even calendar days.
