COVID-19 Update – Mask Wearing in Municipal Facilities**

MARATHON, ON; December 1, 2020 – The Town of Marathon remains diligent in monitoring the situation as it pertains to COVID-19. We continue to evaluate all Public Health Agency communications as well as communications from other Federal and Provincial Government Health Authorities. The health and well-being of our residents is of great importance.

The Emergency Control Group met today and has made the decision that effective December 7, two-layer masks will be required to enter or use municipal facilities. Face coverings, buffs, and handkerchiefs will not be acceptable.

“This is a recommendation from recognized health authorities. Therefore, it only makes sense we implement it to protect our residents, facility users, and town staff. Given the current cases in our community, we need to be proactive in our health and safety planning at this time.” Mayor Rick Dumas.
