The Corporation of the Town of Marathon Pandemic Planning COVID-19 Proof of Vaccination Requirements

MARATHON, ON; Tuesday, March 1, 2022 – The Town of Marathon remains diligent in monitoring the situation as it pertains to COVID-19. We continue to evaluate all Public Health Agency communications as well as communications from other Federal and Provincial Government Health Authorities. The health and well-being of our residents is of great importance.

The Emergency Control Group met on February 28 to review the Ontario public health and safety measures that come into effect as of March 1. These measures include capacity limits lifted in all indoor public settings as well as proof of vaccination requirements lifted (unless an organization or business chooses to implement them voluntarily).

As of March 1, in line with provincial guidelines, proof of vaccination will no longer be required to use Town of Marathon indoor recreation facilities which includes:

- Marathon Arena
- Port Hole Pool
- Lakeview Community Hall
- Marathon Bowling Lanes
- Marathon Cross-Country Ski Club
- Marathon Seniors Club
