

**THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF MARATHON**

**BY-LAW NO. 1980**

Being a by-law to amend By-Law No. 1890, a by-law to regulate and provide for the storage, handling, collection and disposal of waste, and recyclable materials within the Municipality of Marathon.

WHEREAS Section 10 subsection (1), of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25 provides that a single-tier municipality may provide any service or thing the municipality considers necessary or desirable for the public;

AND WHEREAS Section 11 subsections (3) (3) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25 provides for the establishment of a waste management system within the Municipality of Marathon;

AND WHEREAS Section 127 subsections (a) and (b) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25 provides for the regulation of clearing and cleaning land including refuse and debris by the owner or occupier of said land;

AND WHEREAS it is in the interest of society as a whole and the citizens of the Town of Marathon in particular that the amount of waste material generated by the community be reduced and whenever possible such materials be re-used or recycled and that the environment be protected from contamination from hazardous substances;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF MARATHON HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT By-Law No. 1890 is hereby amended as follows:

Section 6.1 be amended to read as follows:

“Occupants shall ensure all residential waste collection receptacles containing residential waste for removal by the collector, shall be placed to the edge of the street, plainly visible to the collector, **between 5:00 A.M. and 7:00 A.M.** local time on the day scheduled for collection”.

2. THAT this By-Law shall come into force and take effect upon the final passing thereof.
